## **Resonator Neuronium Performance** (10pm)

The Performance got its name by the Instrument "Resonator Neuronium" designed by Juergen Michaelis. It is an analog Hardware-Synthesizer based on neuronal relations. For the Performance Juergen Michaelis will generate very experimental noises with his instrument, capable of producing associations with animal or human sounds.

Peggy Sylopp's Visuals are an abstract art: Compositing graphical forms, distorted Video recordings and animated 3D-objects. They are more associated to simple organisms. The animations and effects of the visuals will be controlled by the sounds of the Resonator Neuronium.
